

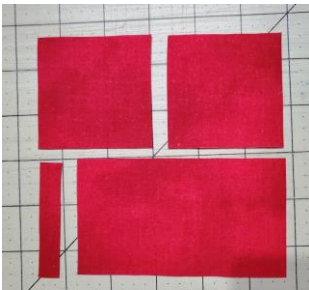
Easy Card Trick Block

You will need 1 background fabric and 4 accent fabrics. You can use yardage, precuts or scraps.

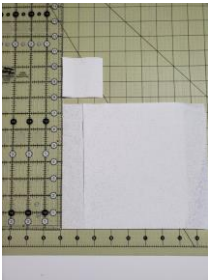
I used 4 charm squares for my accent fabric on a background of white:



I cut each charm square in half. I cut one of the rectangles $4\frac{1}{2}$ inches long and cut the other into two $2\frac{1}{2}$ inch squares, set aside one of them for another project:



From the background I cut four $2\frac{1}{2}$ inch squares and two $7\frac{1}{2}$ inch squares:



Make a four patch using the $2\frac{1}{2}$ inch accent squares:



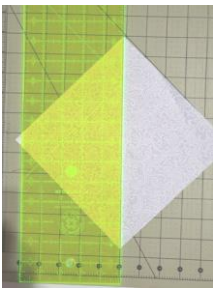
Layout the rectangles and 2 ½ background squares:



Sew together each row, and then sew the rows together matching seams as you go:



Cut the two 7 ½ inch background squares in half, along the diagonal to yield four triangles:



Find the center of each triangle and the center of each side of the block. Match centers and sew in place:



Once all four sides are stitched on, use your ruler to square up the sides and cut off the dog ears:



Now you have your finished 12 ½ inch Easy Card Trick Block!
