

# Las Colcheras Quilt Show 2020 Vision

February 7 & 8, 2020  
General Rules

1. Entries will be taken only on Saturday, January 25, 2020 between 10 AM and 2 PM at Karen Ivey's home, 5272 Redman Road, Las Cruces. A map will be posted on the website.
2. Out-of-town entries may be shipped after January 17 by US Mail (USPS) and must be received by January 24, 2020. Ship to: Raf Chavez, 4316 Summit Lane, Las Cruces NM 88011. Your quilts will be returned to you in the same packaging material in which they were received. All mailed quilts will receive an email confirmation from the guild.
  - \* Include a prepaid label for return insured priority shipping or postage in stamps for return insured priority shipping.
  - \* If you are shipping your quilt but intend to pick it up on Saturday, February 8, enclose a self-addressed stamped envelope in which a receipt will be mailed to you. You must present the receipt when picking up the quilt.
3. Each entry must be accompanied by an entry form. Guild members may enter as many items as they wish, but only one item per category. Non-members are limited to three items, only one item per category.

- \* Entry fees are non-refundable unless a *Display Only* quilt is declined due to space availability.
  - \*\* Guild members must be in good standing prior to Quilt Entry. New memberships and membership renewals must be received by January 22 and will not be accepted at Quilt Entry
4. All entries will be accepted at the discretion of the Show Committee. This committee retains the right to change an entry's placement in a category, combine categories with few entries, and/or split categories with many entries.
  5. Each quilt must be labeled on the back with the name of the quilt and the quilter's name. Items other than quilts should be labeled in an appropriate location.
  6. Each entry must be accompanied by a color photo or other printed image labeled on the back with the entrant's name and phone number. The following information will be required at entry: name of the quilt, category number, size of the quilt (width & length) and top of quilt. If a photo or print is not presented at the time of entry, one can be provided at a cost of \$1.00 per entry. Photos will not be returned.
  7. Each quilt must have a 4" hanging sleeve. Quilts wider than 108 inches must have a split sleeve to accommodate three hangers and the sleeve shall be securely stitched top and bottom with no stitches showing on the front. No entries with frames or glass will be accepted. If special hanging devices are required, prior approval from the quilt show committee is required. If the top of the hanging sleeve is greater than 95 inches above the bottom edge of the quilt, the quilt may rest on the floor.
  8. Quilts will be made of fabric, have 3 layers including a top, batting, and back held together by hand or machine stitches which must be visible on both sides of the quilt, with the exception of Yo-Yo and Cathedral Window quilts. Tied quilts will not be accepted, with the exception of crazy quilts or quilts in Category 1400 – Display.
  9. Indicate on the entry form if the quilt is for sale and the sale price. Las Colcheras will handle the transaction and send a check to the quilt owner less 15%. All quilts will remain hanging until the end of the show.
  10. Judged entries must have been completed after February 18, 2018, be clean, have no odor, and be in excellent condition. Items may not have been shown in any previous show or exhibit sponsored by Las Colcheras Quilt Guild.
  11. Exhibits will be released between 6:00 PM and 6:30 PM only on February 8 at the Convention Center. You must have an entry receipt to pick up an item.
