Her work is an expression of the natural world she sees around her. When Vicki encounters a compelling landscape or subject, her goal is not to replicate it, but rather interpret it in such a way that her emotional connection to it is evident to the viewer. Vicki's work has been exhibited nationally and internationally.

Vicki will teach the same turned edge machine piecing technique she uses for her National Park Quilts. This charming donkey quilt creates an interactive learning experience for choosing fabric and using value to create dimension. You will learn everything you need to know about machine piecing art quilts from cutting the pattern to turning edges and choosing the best background. You will construct the whole quilt on Floriani Stitch-n-Wash Fusible Water Soluble Stabilizer. Use this course for future piecing art quilt projects.

Invisible thread – Superior mono poly – NOT nylon  
Fabric: Lights, mediums and darks for

donkey. (Pick a color & bring a whole basket of fabric in a wide range of value to create a color gradation)  
Various fabrics in chosen background color.
