## Sawtooth Star



The Sawtooth Star is a wonderful block with great visual impact that is super easy to put together. This basic version of the star is made with squares and rectangles.



Make four flying geese units:



For a block that finishes at 12 1/2 inches, Cut the following:

Background (white) Four 3  $1/2 \times 6 \times 1/2$  inch rectangles and Four 3 1/2 inch squares.

Accent (Print) One 6 1/2 inch square and Eight 3 1/2 inch squares.




If you like, mark or press the eight print squares on the diagonal to create a sewing line.

To make your flying geese unit, place 3 1/2 inch print square and white rectangle right sides together and stitch on the diagonal line you marked.



Trim 1/4 inch beyond the seam and press. Then repeat on the other side:



Layout the block for sewing.



Sew in rows, then stitch the rows together. Block should measure 12 1/2 inches when done.
