## 2023 Mystery Quilt

## STEP 2

I will put the small size instructions in parentheses to try to eliminate confusion. Please note in the illustrations that I have put a directional shading on the light squares—this is to show fabric placement if your fabric has a one-way design.


For this step we will use:


All 100 (small size – 24) B <u>LIGHT</u> squares All 100 (small size – 24) A <u>DARK</u> rectangles.

On the wrong side, mark a diagonal line on the B LIGHT squares.

Place the square over the rectangle and sew together on the diagonal from **<u>upper right to lower left</u>**.

It is extremely important that all of these are done the same way.





You can trim away the excess <u>after</u> you are positive you sewed them all correctly, and then **press to the rectangle**. See – triangles – sneaky – huh?!

Special note:

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If your B LIGHT fabric has a directional pattern, place it on the rectangle so that the pattern goes in the same direction as the pictures.
